



**MARTIN MARINE DEEP COVE REGATTA 2022**

**Notice of Race (NoR)**

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing with Sail Canada Prescriptions*.

1.2 *VARC Notice of Race VARC 2022 Championship Season (2022 VARC NOR)*, available at <https://varc.bc.ca/> applies.

1.3 RRS are changed as follows:

- RRS 44.3 is changed, see 12.1
- RRS 78.1 is changed, see 9.3
- RRS A2.1 is changed, see 13.3

1.4 PHRF Sportboat class rules apply.

1.5 The navigation and safety rules of Transport Canada and the Canadian Coast Guard apply.

1.6 [DP] Covid-19 prescriptions from BC Sailing or any overriding governing authority will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available no later than 1800 on September 6, 2022, posted on the DCYC Official Notice Board

[www.deepcoveyc.com/racing](http://www.deepcoveyc.com/racing) and the DCYC homepage.

- 2.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions. Supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at *the DCYC clubhouse* and through the DCYC website.

### 3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at [www.deepcoveyc.com/racing](http://www.deepcoveyc.com/racing).
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel VHF 72
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats that satisfy the *VARC Notice of Race 2022 requirement(s)*.
- 4.2 Divisions and Classes shall be as outlined in *VARC Notice of Race 2022/ section 3.2.1*
- 4.3 A minimum of 3 registered boats are required to constitute a fleet.
- 4.4 Eligible boats may enter by registering online using the Gift tool registration link on [www.deepcoveyc.com/racing](http://www.deepcoveyc.com/racing) by 0900 Saturday, September 10, 2022 completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee,
- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.6 Check-in is required by all boats at least 10 minutes prior to the first warning signal of each day by either sailing within two boat-lengths to leeward of the RC signal boat or over VHF 72.



5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees for vessel registration are as follows:

6 ADVERTISING

6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

7 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

7.1 The event will constitute as a qualifying series as described in *VARC Notice of Race/ VARC 2022 Championship Season/Table 1 VARC Schedule of Events*.

8 SCHEDULE

8.1 Registration: On-line only from Friday, August 1, to 0900 Saturday, September 10, 2022.

8.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100 hrs.

8.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1430 hrs.

## 9 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1 Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid PHRF of BC or ORC Club rating certificate.

9.2 Boats may be inspected at any time.

9.3 [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 when presented for inspection. A penalty may be assessed for non-compliance.

## 10 VENUE

10.1 The area is the waters in Burrard Inlet East of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Narrows Bridge, inclusive of Indian Arm.

## 11 COURSES

11.1 The course(s) to be sailed will be as follows:

11.2 The marks will be used as follows: port rounding.

## 12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, does not apply.

## 13 SCORING

13.1 The scoring system is as follows: The TCF rating system applies to boats racing under the ORC class(es). The PHRF ToT rating system

applies to boats racing under PHRF of BC class(es).

13.2 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.3 Each day will constitute as a qualifying series as described in *VARC Notice of Race/ VARC 2022 Championship Season/10.1.3* A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores (this changes RRS A2.1).

13.4 Rule A5.3 applies.

#### 14 BERTHING

14.1 [DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat harbour

#### 15 RISK STATEMENT

15.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.** The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta(s).

#### 16 INSURANCE

16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2 Million per incident or the equivalent.

#### 17 PRIZES

17.1 Prizes will be given as follows: in the DCYC Clubhouse following each day's racing.

### **MOORAGE**

Limited free rafting moorage available on a first come/first serve basis. Boats are required to check-in with the Moorage Coordinator on the docks as they arrive. Due to limited moorage at the DCYC docks, non-competitor boats (hotel boats) are requested to anchor out adjacent to the docks or moor at the Government dock.
