NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The Organizing Authority for the Regatta is the Deep Cove Yacht Club.



- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.3 All boats will sail according to the rules of PHRF BC. ORC Club boats will subsequently be scored according to VARC rules for VARC standings.
- 1.4 All boats must comply with Transport Canada and Canadian Coast Guard regulations, and Pacific International Yachting Association (PIYA) Safety Equipment Requirements (SER) Category Nearshore or ISAF Off Shore Regulations Category 4, as amended in the VARC Notice of Race 1.5.4.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats that have a current PHRF or BC certificate with a rating no higher than 275 or a current ORC Club Certificate with a rating no higher than 640.
- 2.2 Boats may register for the regatta Online using the Gift tool registration link on Deepcoveyc.com/racing

OR

In person at the DCYC Regatta Office on Friday, September 6, 2019 from 1800-2100hrs

3. FEES

\$60 if post marked or paid online by August 31, 2019

\$75 if post marked or paid online after August 31, 2019 OR in person at DCYC Registration Friday, September 6, 2019.

4. SCHEDULE

1. Dates of racing are Saturday, September 7, 2019 & Sunday, September 8, 2019.

2. The first warning signal shall be made at 11:55 hrs on both days.

3. Complete schedule of events will be posted online at the Deep Cove Yacht Club homepage <u>www.deepcoveyc.com/racing.php</u>

4. Prize presentation will be in the DCYC Clubhouse following racing on Saturday and Sunday, September 7 and 8 2019.

5. Brewery keg on the dock after racing followed by BBQ at the clubhouse

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Sailing Instructions shall be available no later than Friday, September 6, 2019. Sailing Instructions and Notices to Competitors shall be posted online at the Deep Cove Yacht Club homepage <u>www.deepcoveyc.com/racing.php</u>. Notices will also be posted on the Official Notice Board located at the DCYC clubhouse.





6. RACING AREA

Racing will take place in Burrard Inlet East of the 2nd Narrows Bridge and in the Indian Arm.

7. MOORAGE

Limited free rafting moorage on a first come/first serve basis is available on Friday and Saturday nights. Boats are requested to check in with the Moorage Coordinator on the dock as they arrive. In general, the gate and the lower level of the club house will be open and accessible during daytime hours for the duration of the regatta. A limited number of keys are available for gate and clubhouse access during night-time hours. A \$20.00 key deposit will be required. Due to limited moorage at the DCYC docks, non-competitor boats (Hotel Boats) are requested to anchor out adjacent to the docks or moor at the Government dock. Thank you for your cooperation.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta

9. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover \$2 Million per event or the equivalent.
